## **BYLAW NO. 2-2018**

## A BYLAW OF THE DUNDURN RURAL WATER UTILITY TO ESTABLISH PENALTIES FOR METER TAMPERING

The BOARD of the Dundurn Rural Water Utility, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. This bylaw may be referred to as the "Meter Tampering Penalty Bylaw".
- 2. "Utility" means the Dundurn Rural Water Utility.
- 3. "Subscriber" means a person, organization or corporation who has the authority to sign a Subscriber application and Agreement with the Utility.
- 4. Every subscriber who contravenes any provision of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction:
  - a. In the case of any tampering, altering or modifying any part on the meter assembly board, the penalties will be:
    - a. First offence Zero Tolerance \$100.00
    - b. Second offence Zero Tolerance \$500.00
    - c. Third offence Zero Tolerance 500.00 and possible stop of service.
